Our website went live on Friday 23rd June and by 8pm that evening we had our first booking for the 25th August! We were planning on a test run with family and friends but shortly afterwards received more bookings. Both tents were soon fully booked well into the first week of September – much to our family and friends' disappointment to have missed out on being test dummies! We now have every weekend in September full and only 2 weekends available in October and I received a booking request today for the very last weekend! We have received some lovely feedback and are currently rated 5 out of 5 on our website and Facebook! Please see some of the comments below.

A friend suggested we hold an open afternoon and BBQ to which we invited our neighbours and locals from the village. It was a huge success and due to the power of social media we had people popping in from the surrounding villages too. Other diversification of the safari tents has included accommodation for friends and relatives visiting people in the village – there are no local hotels so this has been a popular alternative to staying 20 minutes away in the town. We also have a number of boarding schools locally and parents visiting their children who want to take them out for the weekend have expressed interest in booking during term time.

We have met some lovely families and it is a real joy to see their reaction when they see the two safari tents. We have good quality furnishings with nice bedding, free WiFi, heating, good lighting & each tent has its own shower room with heated towel rail and complimentary toiletries. Our two tents are called Juniper and Mulberry and each has its own colour scheme and individual touches. We have also linked with a number of local businesses whose services can be pre-booked; these include a freelance beauty therapist who comes to site to do manicures, pedicures, massages (very popular with groups of ladies and special occasions), anniversary and birthday packages with The Horse Drawn Carriage Company who offer champagne picnic drives (for which we offer a drop off and pick up service), as well as complimentary membership to our local village club which offers a range of entertainment, comedy and music nights.
